Legislative Update

- 1). Elimination of Temporary Snowmobile Registration** – It looks very promising that a law to eliminate the temporary snowmobile registration will pass this year. Snowmobiles will no longer need to display registrations numbers. Instead, we will issue a larger set of stickers like we now do with ATVs. There will no longer be any temporary snowmobile registrations. This will make things easier for agents, customers, and IF&W.

- 2). Superpack to Include Expanded Archery Permits** – It looks very promising that a law to change the Superpack license to include expanded archery permits will pass this year. This should make our customers happy and will also be easier for agents and IF&W.

- 3). Combining Milfoil and Boat Registration Stickers** – It looks very promising that a law to combine the resident milfoil and boat registration stickers will pass this year. The milfoil sticker will be combined with the boat registration sticker and the price of the combined item will be increased by \$10. If a boat is to be used on tidal waters only, the agent will clip the milfoil portion of the sticker off and charge the customer \$10 less. For MOSES agents, the two choices (with or without milfoil) will be available as part of the normal boat registration process. The non-resident milfoil sticker will remain the same as it is now. (Show proposed stickers).

- 4). Other rumors or questions on legislation?** – There are a number of other laws that have been proposed. Many of these do not look like they are going to pass. A number of them have not been discussed yet. But, I will answer questions on them if you have any.

ATV Materials, Expired Inventory

- 1). You will be receiving all your 2008 ATV registration materials in late April to start selling on May 1, 2007. Please remind your ATV registration customers that come in to register in April that if they wait until May 1 to register that their registration will be valid until June 30, 2008.
- 2). If you have not already done so, please send in all your 2006 expired unsold inventory. We are currently working on balancing all agent accounts for the 2006 year and we need your unsold inventory to do this.

MOSES Update

- 1). We currently have around 190 agents on-line selling licenses and registrations on MOSES. We have new agents coming on-line all the time.
- 2). We will continue to offer both license and registration training classes throughout the State until all agents who want to go on-line have been trained. We still have agents on our training waiting list but the list is get smaller. In addition, all existing agents who wish to send additional people to training classes will be able to do so (and we encourage you to do so). Please call Dale Freise at 287-4117 if you want to get on our waiting list. We have a MOSES license training class in Lewiston on April 17th and 18th. We still have room in that class. We have a MOSES license and registration class scheduled in Presque Isle in early May. We will be scheduling additional classes in Orono and Lewiston throughout the summer and fall.
- 3). Recent MOSES defect fixes and/or enhancements:
 - Remove “Duplicate License” from the Main Menu.** This selection was for use by IF&W to issue lifetime license duplicates and was confusing to Agents trying to issue a duplicate through the Sales Menu
 - Remove “Account Notice Summary” from the Reports Menu.** This report did not contain all of the information the Agents needed and was confusing. Agents should use the Account Notice report.
 - Remove “Transfer To” and “Upgrade” from the Registration Events screen.** “Transfer From” is the correct method to do a transfer.
 - Change all vehicle model years that are less than 4 digits in the database to 4 digits.**

Some of the older vehicles that were in the databases that were copied into MOSES had just the last two digits of the model year. MOSES saw a 2 digit model year as an error and would not allow the Agent to renew the vehicle registration.

-Add a Warning Screen if a Renewal is being done on a vehicle that is currently registered. There are times that a customer will want to renew a current registration by mistake. They may have forgotten that they had already registered the vehicle or another member of the family may have done the registration. MOSES will present a warning screen that the vehicle has a current registration and ask you if you want to proceed. You would want to proceed if it is a couple of weeks before the beginning of the new registration period and the customer is getting ready for the new season.

-Changed the Agent fees for New, Rollover and Transfers. The agent fee for these registration events is now \$2. The Renewal Agent Fee is correct at \$1.

-Extend time-out time to 30 minutes. The MOSES system will allow you to stay logged into the system for 30 minutes now without activity before it logs you out. The time was previously set to 15 minutes.

4). MOSES defect fixes and/or enhancements we are working on:

-Fix problem in Download to PC functionality for TRIO software. In the pilot testing of the MOSES interface to TRIO in the town of Bucksport, an error was found with one particular transaction type. We are working on correcting this defect so pilot testing can continue.

-Fix problem where doing a Duplicate Registration inactivates the vehicle.

-Print Excise Tax on Boat Registration.

-Allow up to 7 items on the MOSES license before it goes to a second page.
